Program Itinerary

- 7 September (Sunday)
- * Morning: Self-drive to Bukit Mertajam.
 - * 3:00 PM — Assemble at the hotel lobby.
 - * 4:00 PM — Depart to photograph the making of Tua Pek Kong statue and other related activities.
 - * Evening: Free activities; enjoy the festive night atmosphere of Bukit Mertajam.
- 8 September (Monday)
- * 9:00 AM — Gather at the hotel lobby; proceed to photograph the dragon joss stick making process until noon.
 - * Noon: Lunch.
 - * Afternoon: Visit and photograph a coffee factory, traditional wooden clog makers, and other cultural craft scenes.
 - * Late afternoon: Return to the hotel for rest.
 - * Evening: Dinner followed by photographing the Tua Pek Kong festival celebration, including devotees performing purification rituals, prayers, and offerings until the event concludes.
 - * Note: Participants from outstation are free to stay an extra night or return home after the event.
- 9 September (Tuesday)
- * Free and easy; participants may plan their own activities or additional shoots.

Rules & Guidelines

- 1) This event is organized as a photographic exchange to promote artistic interaction and improve members' skills. There is no participation fee, only a symbolic contribution of RM10 per person to cover drinks or tips for craftsmen and workers.
- 2) The itinerary is flexible; participants are required to arrange their own transport to allow maximum personal convenience.
Accommodation and travel insurance are not included; however, the society can provide hotel recommendations for participants to book online.
Participants are solely responsible for their personal safety and any incidents during the event; the society shall not be held liable for any accidents or injuries. We appreciate your kind understanding.
